Mathletics update

MATHLETICS UPDATE!

We had expected the children's Mathletics accounts to be reset at the beginning of September so they would be starting the new academic year with Bronze 1 being their first certificate. However, by resetting it in this way, the children would lose their avatar, all accumulated points and require a new password. For these reasons we have decided that the children will just carry on using Mathletics as it is currently set up and points achieved will be added to those already attained.

Previously, the children were working towards achieving their Gold Certificate by the end of the year. This now means children could be achieving their Gold Certificate much earlier – depending on how far they got last year. We will still celebrate Silver and Gold certificates in assemblies by presenting them to the children. Gold medals will be given to the children who manage to achieve 1000 points, twenty times, during the course of the school year, thus completing the Mathletics tracker chart in their classroom. Class teachers will be explaining this to the children.

Please remember that there is a Mathletics / homework club open to Years 3 to 6 in the computer room; Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday mornings from 8.25am to 8.45am. With regards,
