Sports Days

Next week we will be holding our annual sports days as follows:

11th June -9.30-11.15am – Morning Nursery, RT and RD

11th June -1.00-2.45pm –All Day Nursery, Afternoon Nursery and RA (gate opens 1pm)

Following this event Nursery and Reception children can be collected early. For RA children this will be via their door which opens onto the pathway next to the car park. For Nursery children this will be from the usual collection gate. Please note if taking children early you will be unable to collect older siblings at this time. Collection of siblings will be at their usual finishing times.

In case of postponement further dates have been reserved. We will endeavour to let you know (via text, our website and our official Facebook site) if we need to postpone an event due to adverse weather conditions. We will notify you of a morning postponement by 8.30am or an afternoon postponement by 12.30pm.

Practical matters:

Parents/family will all be able to access the school field via the gate between Church and Woodrush's astro turf (Year 1 gate). The gate will be open in the mornings for families from 8.45am and will be manned until 9.45am. In the afternoon, gates will open at 1.20pm and will be manned until 1.45pm. If you arrive after the gates are shut, you will need to go to the school office to be escorted through school.

When you enter the playground/ field you will be directed to the seating area. Please do not leave the field area or enter any of the school buildings. If you wish to use our toilet facilities you will be directed to the new block disabled toilet outside the 1T classroom, next to the Infant Hall.

The children will be sitting on the opposite side of the running track to their families. Please do not cross the track to go to them. In addition please keep younger children off the race track at all times.

If you need to leave early for any reason, do not leave through school but please ask a member of staff for assistance.

Regarding taking photographs at school events, as we have mentioned before, you are welcome to take photographs of your own children but please do not share photos of other people's children on social media. We have children in school whose photos **must not** appear online.

I hope you understand that safeguarding the children in school is our number one priority and we trust that you will assist us with this.

The PTA will be selling drinks to adults before the morning Sports Days and ice lollies to everyone after afternoon Sports Days (Y6 will be selling ice lollies to raise funds for their leaving party after the Y5 & 6 sports day).
