#### **Head Teacher's News**

#### Welcome back and a Happy New Year to you all.

We always have a lot to celebrate at the Coppice and it is great to start off the New Year with some wonderful news about attendance.

On Monday, one hundred and eighty five children were presented with their "Bronze 100% Attendance Star" for the Autumn Term. This equates to around one third of all the children from Reception through to Year 6 being here every day, representing a significant achievement, for which these children can feel rightly proud! The stars can be worn on either sweatshirts or ties with the children free to choose which option they prefer. Infants obviously will wear them on sweatshirts. Please encourage your child to look after their badge. If they do lose it you can purchase

a replacement from the school office for £1.

Please remember that this is a reward for just the first term. Therefore, if your child didn't achieve the badge or just narrowly missed out, they can still earn their Bronze Badge if they attend for every day of this term. For those children who achieved the Bronze Star this time, they will now have the opportunity to go for their Silver Star for 100% attendance in the Spring Term as well. This means that every child still has something to aim for!

Remember too that any child with 98% attendance for the whole of this academic year (up to the cut-off point in the Summer Term) will receive the attendance treat in the last week of the academic year.
