Head Teacher's News

Safety on site and beyond.

We have had a 'near miss' between pedestrians and a car on site recently. We appreciate that access to and from school can be quite congested at pick-up and drop-off, so the opportunities for accidents are increased. We urge parents to be vigilant, particularly on behalf of their children, keeping them in check. We know that there are plenty of situations in life where pedestrians have to navigate their way through car parks. Accordingly, taking a sensible line, we are not banning pedestrians from the car park. However, we would strongly recommend the use of our footpaths wherever possible. We cannot take responsibility for accidents within our car park due to lack of alertness on behalf of pedestrians and drivers.

Obviously, we are aware of traffic issues in the neighbourhood immediately beyond our school grounds, and have made attempts to alleviate this by trying to negotiate a second entrance, but unfortunately, we have not been supported by Bromsgrove Council with this (though I understand Councillor Adam Kent is making some enquiries on our behalf). We have had similar issues with trying to establish a much needed pedestrian crossing - we must be the only primary school in the whole of Worcestershire (if not the whole country) that neighbours a large high school, and does not have a crossing!

In the meantime, please park safely and considerately, staying away from the yellow zig-zags and the entrances to neighbourhood driveways.

PE Kit reminder

Just a gentle reminder about PE Kits. We consider it important that pupils come to school wearing our school uniform. All pupils have regular P.E sessions during the week (Foundation/KS1 - 1 hour. KS2 - 2 hours). The correct PE kit for indoor PE should be:

- White tee shirt.
- Navy or black shorts.
- Pumps or low sided trainers in a pump bag (making sure pumps fit your child correctly).

For outdoor PE children should have:

- White tee shirt.
- Navy or black shorts.
- Suitable trainers (trainers which have been worn outside cannot be worn for dance/gymnastics and indoor games).
- Navy or black jogging bottoms (not branded).

It is essential that pupils are properly dressed. Children should not wear jewellery on PE days and earrings are to be removed/covered with tape before starting PE. This rule must be adhered to for safety reasons. We would like to thank parents for their ongoing support and cooperation.
