### Year 5 Maths Challenge



On Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> June, 4 of our Year 5 mathematicians were invited to compete in the finals of a mathematics challenge at King Edward's School. The competition was fierce with some of the best mathematicians from other schools competing.

Over the course of the afternoon, there were two challenges for the children to complete. The first was a challenging cross number puzzle with questions such as, "There are seven football teams which must each play each other once. How many games are played?" and "What is the lowest 3 digit number that is also a palindrome?"

Next, was an exciting maths relay which had all of the children up and running around the hall collecting thought provoking reasoning questions to answer? After a fascinating presentation about shapes from "Think Maths", the winners were finally announced and we are thrilled to share that Coppice came first! To put this into perspective, there were ten heats each with ten schools to then decide which teams were going to the finals So, the Coppice was the top school out of 100 schools!

The children received a prize each and brought The Borchers Shield back to school for us to display in our trophy cabinet.

A massive well done and congratulations to Joel F, Bella W, Katie B and Ayesha R for your triumphant victory!

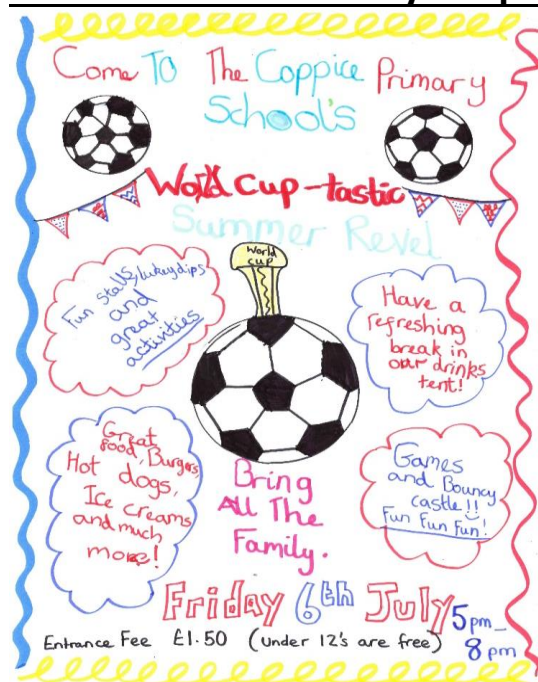
The challenge runs until Sunday night when the scores will be reset as usual. So please don't stop using Mathletics when you finish school on Friday – keep going!
