They will continue to secure their use of capital letters and full stops and develop their sentence composition. The children will be introduced to using prefixes and suffixes in their writing. The children will be sequencing events in chronological order using language for example, before and after, next, first, today, yesterday, tomorrow, morning, afternoon and evening. Recognise and use language relating to dates, including days of the week, weeks, months and years. Tell the time to the hour and half past the hour and draw the hands on a clock face to show these times The children will be developing their addition and subtraction skills by solving missing number problems, representing and using number bonds.
