Dear Parents and Carers,

A big welcome back to all of you after the Christmas break! I hope that all of you managed to have an enjoyable time with your children, family and friends. Obviously, if you or anyone in your family were unfortunately affected by illness, as I know some of our staff were, I sincerely hope that you are on the mend and will be back to full health soon.

We are looking forward with great excitement to the new term and hopefully your children have come home feeling positive about the way that school has started for them. From my walks around school over the last couple of days, the children have settled really well back into 'The Coppice Way' routines and expectations, are working hard on

their learning and, most importantly, are happy to be back.

Celebration assemblies:

On Wednesday and Thursday of this week, we held our Celebration Assembles for Years 1-6, where we celebrated all of the excellent learning that took place over the course of the last half-term and, once again, they were lovely occasions.

During the assemblies, we awarded the half-termly 'star' trophies to a child in each year group for the following categories: Humanities (Geography, History, Religious Education, Spanish), Writing, Reading, Maths, Science, Sport, Arts, Design and Technology, Computing and 'The Coppice Way'.

We also awarded our Gold, Silver and Bronze Teampoint medals for the top three teampoint earners in each class. I also reminded all of the children how they should be proud of every Teampoint they earn because each one represents something that they have achieved, which is always cause for celebration.

Each teampoint also contributes to the overall team totals which means that, by the end of the year, one of the four teams: Owls, Hawks, Falcons or Eagles will be crowned House Champions - always an exciting end to the year!





Current overall totals are:

Eagles: 10,358 points Hawks: 11,884 points

Falcons: 11,577 points Owls: 12,367 points

I also want to say a big well done to all of the children for all of the team points that they earned. Every team point counts towards the total and every team point represents something that a child has achieved, which is always a cause for celebration!

This week, I have asked all Class Teachers to speak to any Parents and Carers if they see that a child in their class is not meeting the uniform expectations in full.

The reasons that I wish for all of our children to have the same, high standard in both school uniform and PE kit is that it gives our children a clear identity. It shows that they all belong to The Coppice Primary School. I want children to feel that they belong to their school and to be proud of it.

It is also really important to me that the uniform and PE/Forest School kit expectations outlined are both achievable and affordable for all Parents and Carers. Therefore, as a school, we make decisions that we believe enable this to be the case. We do not want to exclude anyone or pose challenges financially for any of our Parents or Carers with our expectations. For example, we do not expect an embroidered logo on anything **apart from** their school sweatshirt, jumper or cardigan. Everything else can be plain.

I know that I can count on your support with the expectations outlined above and the reasons for them. However, I do need to point out that these expectations are non-negotiable and are the required standard for ALL pupils. Please ensure that your child is properly prepared to meet them – thank you everyone.

Our school also accepts donations for pre-loved items of uniform which are then made available to other families who struggle with the costs of buying new uniform. There will be regular opportunities for you to look through and take any items you may require. Please ask at the school office if there is an item you need and they may be able to help, depending on the sizes that are in our stock.

Can I end by saying that it is absolutely vital that items are named and labelled. It really is upsetting to see so many good quality lost items being handed in that we cannot return.
